

🌸 A Note from Our School Nurse 🌸

REV 3-2018

The PA Department of Health requires the following for your child's school health record. Any student, whose records are not in compliance with the state laws, may be excluded from school.

Please forward the proper medical information for the school year 2018-2019.

Immunizations-Any New student, regardless of grade, MUST submit immunization records.

For attendance in ALL GRADES in 2018-19 children need the following:

- 🌸 4 doses of tetanus* (1 dose on or after the 4th birthday)
- 🌸 4 doses of diphtheria* (1 dose on or after the 4th birthday)
- 🌸 3 doses of polio *Usually given as DTP or DTaP or DT or Td
- 🌸 2 doses of measles** **Usually given as MMR
- 🌸 2 doses of mumps**
- 🌸 1 dose of rubella (German measles)**
- 🌸 3 doses of hepatitis B
- 🌸 2 doses of varicella (chickenpox) vaccine or history of disease

Grades 7th-12th will also need the following immunizations:

- 🌸 1 dose of tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (Tdap) (if 5 years has elapsed since last tetanus immunization)
- 🌸 ~~1 dose~~ 2 doses of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV) Dept. of Health revised doses March 2017

Physical Exams-Any New student, regardless of grade, MUST submit a current physical:

- 🌸 **All New Students** entering MCS must submit a current physical exam along with a copy of current immunizations.
- 🌸 **Students in grades 6th and 11th** must submit a current completed physical exam for that year.
- 🌸 **Nursery, Jr. Kindergarten, and Kindergarten/ or 1st grade** (whichever comes first) **students:** must submit each year a current physical exam along with a copy of immunizations.

Dental Exams

- 🌸 **All New (Kindergarten-12th) Students** entering MCS must submit a current completed dental exam.
- 🌸 Students entering school must submit a current completed dental exam.
Entry into school is considered to be Kindergarten or 1st grade, whichever comes first.
- 🌸 **Students in grades 3rd and 7th** must submit a current completed dental exam.

NOTE: All physicals and dental exam reports are considered current if dated no later than one year prior to the first day of school. Dental, physical, and medication forms are available from the school receptionist or from our website at mcsliions.org.
